An actual alert will cycle through for 5 minutes. Head inside and check online or radio for updates.

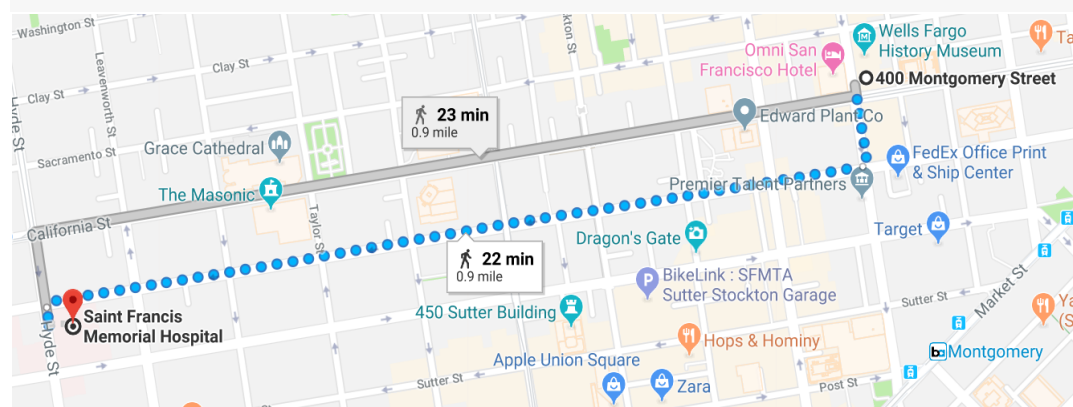
Building Fire Drills

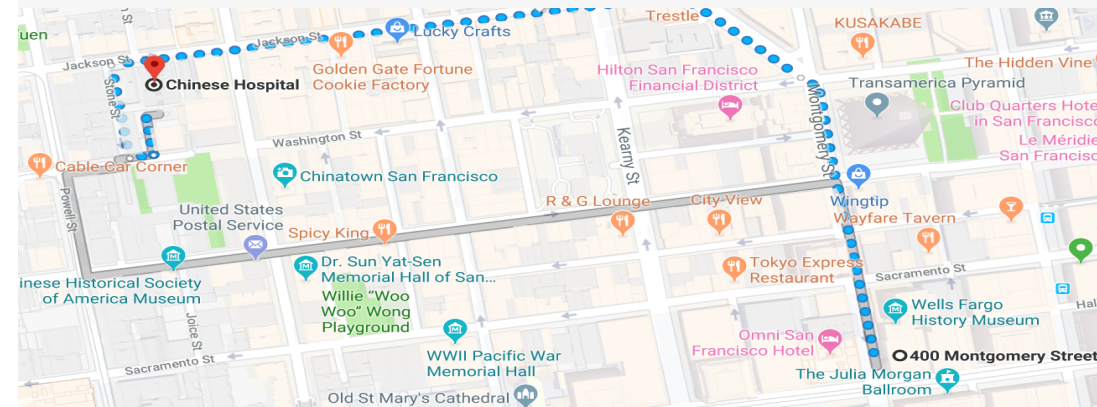

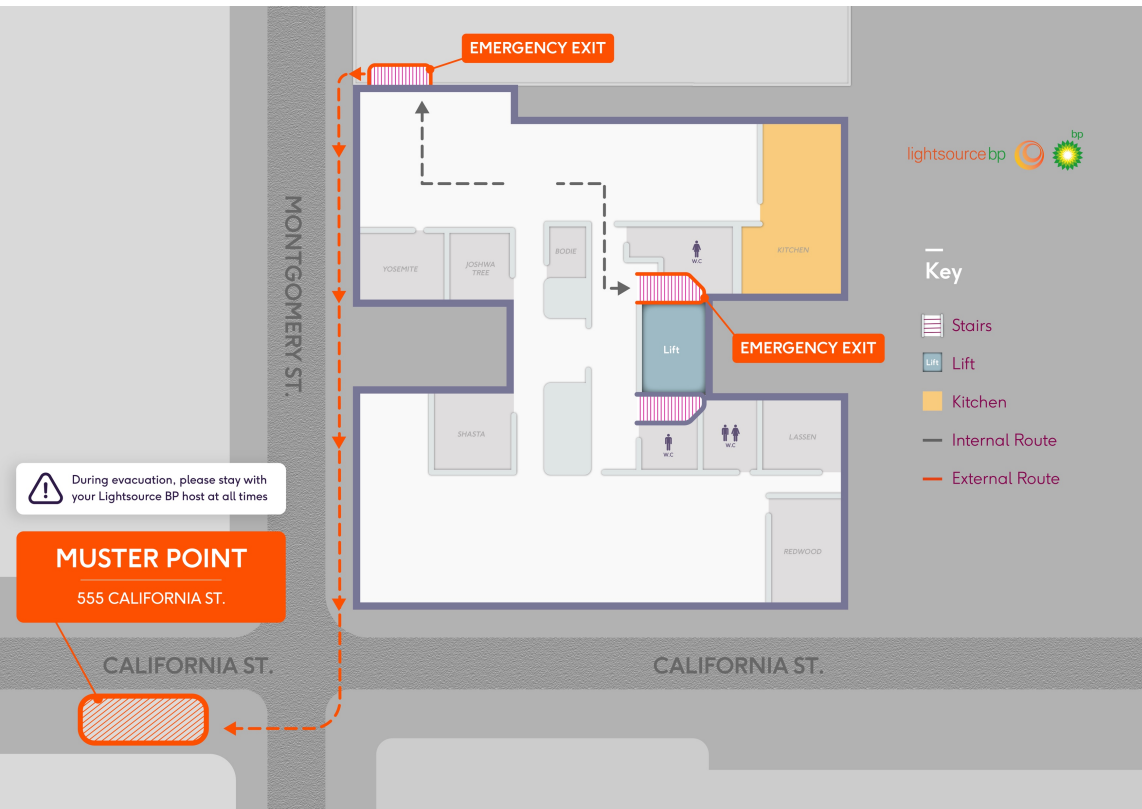

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During a Fire/Evacuation:

1. **Keep calm and walk swiftly towards the exit/stairwell. Do not run.** If there is smoke in the air, crawl close to the ground.
2. **Take the stairs.** Do not use the elevator. Close the doors behind you and do not return for personal belongings.
3. **Meet at 555 California.**



During an Earthquake:

1. **Drop, cover and hold on.** Drop down and get under a strong table or drop against an interior wall and cover your head and neck with your arms. Stay away from windows.
2. **Stay put.** Wait until the shaking stops.
3. **Stay calm.** Keep calm and carry on.



After an Earthquake:

1. **Check your surroundings.** Check for damage, and for anyone who is injured and in need of attention.
2. **Check SF72.org, KGO 810, KCBS 740 or KNBR 680.** Listen to the radio for important information and instructions. Aftershocks, which often follow large quakes, can cause damage too.
