**Representative Viewpoint 4 (Left) - Bridge across Anglesey Central Railway to south-east of Former Oil Depot near Rhosgoch**

**Existing View**

This viewpoint located on the railway bridge to the south east of the Former Oil Depot and is representative of motorists using the unclassified lane to the north west of a crossroads. The foreground to the right of the view comprises the high-way stretching towards the Former Oil Depot and stone bridge, with open gently sloping geometric fields beyond and continuing to the left of the view, where the Anglesey Central Railway line and self colonised scrub is visible. The midground view comprises geometric pastoral fields bordered by a mixture of drystone walls, hedgerows and stock proof fencing. The background to the left of the view is foreshortened by rising topography and vegetation, with the Former Oil Depot visible to the centre left and centre right of the view. Existing infrastructure including the Rhyd-y-groes Wind Farm and the Porth Wen Solar Farm is visible in the middle distance to the centre right, while overhead lines cross to the right of the view.

**Operation Phase**

Maen Hir North would be visible in the midground to the north-west and north-east of the viewpoint. To the left of the view, the eastern edge of Maen Hir North is visible in the midground at Field 38. To the centre left of the view, solar arrays would be visible near the Former Oil Depot and Fields 37 and 41. To the centre right of the view, Field 32 is visible in the midground, while the fields near Trogog Uchaf are visible on the middle slopes of the drumlin landform. To the right of the view, Field 23 can be glimpsed beyond the property at Bodelffra. During the operation phase, the likely scale of effect would be **Large** (adverse) reducing to a **Medium** (adverse) once the embedded mitigation has established.
