Existing View

This view is representative of motorists near Celgyrog Blas and Mynydd Mechell, on the boundary of Maen Hir North. The foreground to the left of the view comprises an unclassified lane, which is bordered by drystone walls and stock proof fencing. To the left and centre, the view is largely foreshortened by landform but there are some glimpsed long distance views towards Wylfa Head to the left and open geometric fields on gently rolling hills towards the centre. An elevated coastal area can be seen in the far distance. To the right of the centre, the Porth Wen Solar Farm can be seen in the distance where the landform rises, above gorse and scrub in the midground view. Isolated properties and farms can be seen nestled between medium to large and undulating pastoral fields. Wind turbines and the 400kV pylons and overhead line feature strongly in the views' skyline. To the right of the view, geometric fields in the midground rises towards the rocky outcrops of Mynydd Mechell which foreshortens the view.

Operation Phase

Maen Hir North would be visible to the north of the viewpoint. Field 51 (mitigation and enhancement area) will be visible to the left and centre of the foreground although this field will not contain any solar infrastructure. To the centre of the view, there will be glimpsed, oblique views of the north western corner of Maen Hir North on the slope of a drumlin landform around Hafodllin Bach. To the right of the view, the south west corner of Maen Hir North can be seen sitting prominently on a drumlin in the midground view in front of vegetation enclosing the Former Oil Depot and Fields 60 and 62. There may be glimpsed views into the Former Oil Depot containing the proposed BESS and Project Substation. The south western edge of Maen Hir North would be screened by intervening topography. During the operation phase, the scale of effect is likely to be a **Medium** (adverse) prior to and following the establishment of the embedded mitigation.
